Recent projects include *Chroma Streams; Tide and Traffic*, a site-specific integrated light installation exploring the relationship between the flow of traffic and the changing tides below Kingston Bridge in Glasgow, Scotland. Another project, a towering landmark in Brooklyn, New York – the Coney Island Parachute Jump, designed illumination reflects calendar events and tidal patterns all-year-round. Lighting design for the Conservatory at The New York Botanical Gardens is currently underway.

Light Projects studio has enjoyed extensive press and media coverage. Leni Schwendinger has lectured and taught widely throughout the United States, Europe and Japan, and is currently on the faculty of Parsons School of Design; Architecture, Interior Design and Lighting Department, in New York City.
