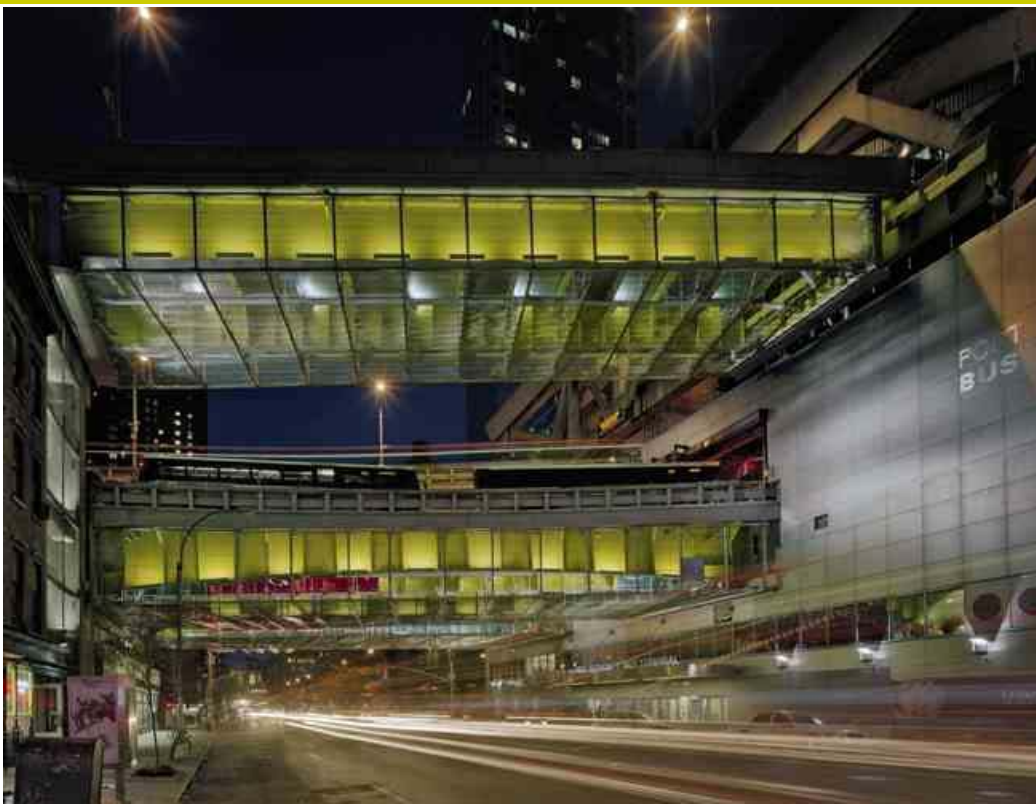

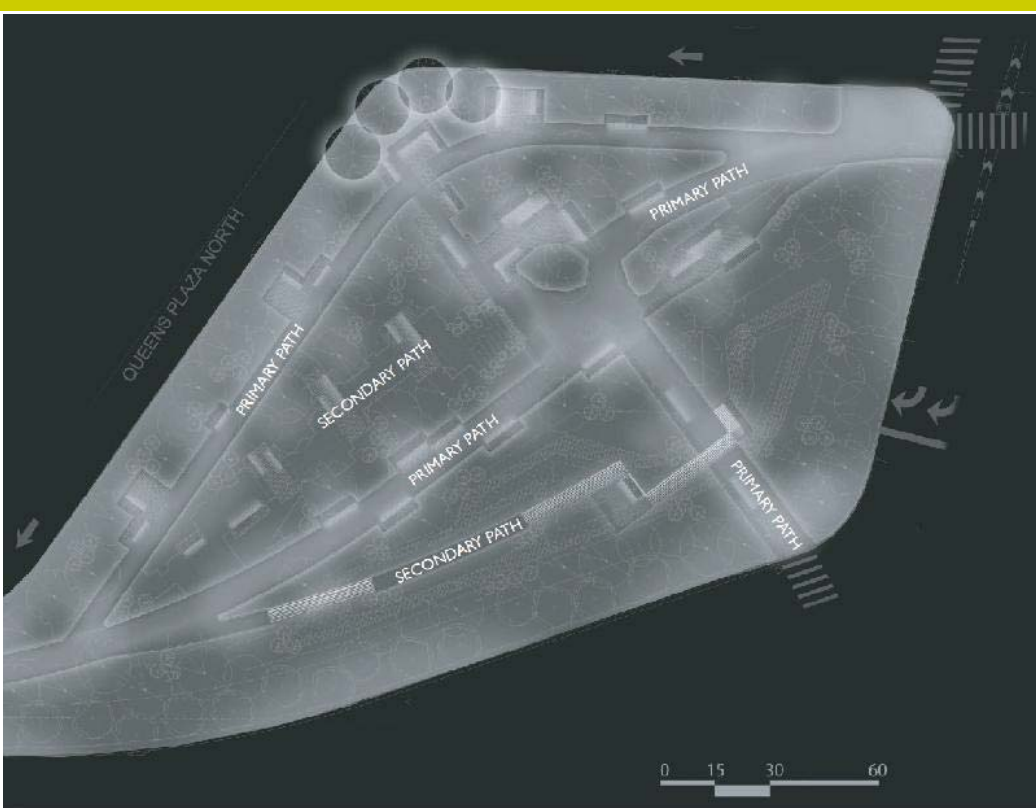
Flatbush Avenue Streetscape Masterplan Brooklyn, NY
